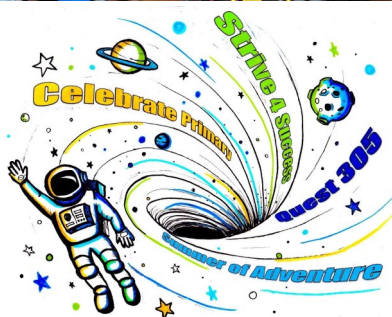

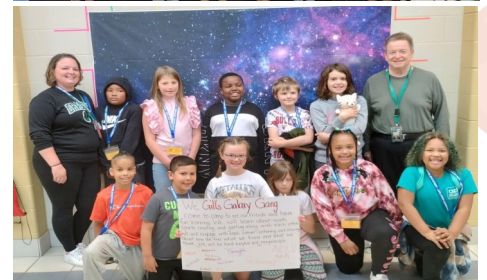
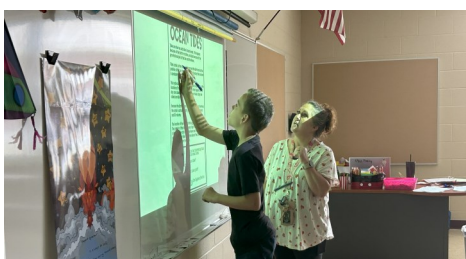


# STRIVE FOR SUCCESS

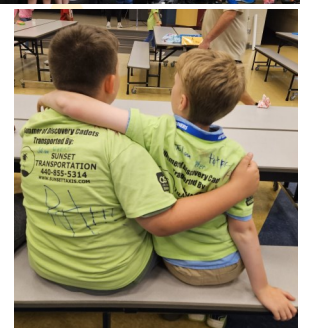
