ASD Programs were funded by 21st CCLC Ohio Department of Education Grants, ESSER Summer Create Grant, District Contracts, Foundation Grants, Local Community Personal and Business Donations along with Family/ODJFS Payments for the Discovery Cove Child Care Center

PROGRAM OUTCOMES:

1 hour of academics each day

1 hour of an enrichment each day

Social/emotional learning each day

Field Trips offered in connection with programming

15 Family & Community Events with 596 adults in attendance and 291 students represented

ATTENDANCE OUTCOMES: 83% of Quest Jr High students, 74% of Discovery Cove Students, 64% of Strive Students and 62% of the Celebrate Students attended over 90% of their school days. AACCS District has a chronic absenteeism rate of 45%. ASD is supporting the efforts of AACCS to keep our students present in the school day!

STUDENT OUTCOMES from School Day Teacher Surveys: 87% Quest Jr High Students and 94% of the Celebrate students showed an improvement in their behaviors & academics during the school day. ASD is planting seeds to improve students' behaviors and work ethic.

STUDENT GRADE OUTCOMES: QUEST: Math 73% and ELA 64% of students showed improvement; CELEBRATE 87% of students mastered or showed improvement in Reading and Math; DISCOVERY COVE: Math 89% and Reading 72% of students showed improvement; STRIVE 4 SUCCESS: Math & Reading 68% of students showed improvement or maintained a B or higher on their report card.

ASD's School Year / Fiscal Year 2024-2025 has brought many budget DECREASES that are affecting our world of programming. ASD's Quest & Celebrate programs have received a cut of \$150,000; the Strive Program a cut of \$20,000; and our personal and business donations have all decreased, while in the meantime the need for this programming has INCREASED. To meet these funding cuts ASD has reduced the number of days of service for each program and reduced the number of students that we can serve in each program.

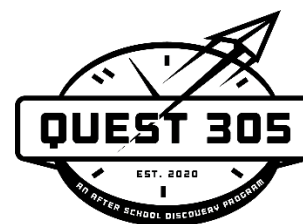
